POLICY ON CONTROLLED F.O.R.C.E. SUSTAINMENT REINFORCEMENT TRAINER CERTIFICATION

The Controlled F.O.R.C.E. Mechanical Advantage Control Holds™ (M.A.C.H.) based training system has been established as the DOD standard for non-lethal weapons and tactics Close Range Subject Control (CRSC) training through the INIWIC program. The system has also been integrated into the U.S. Army MP Schoolhouse, U.S. Marine Corps MP Schoolhouse, U.S. Navy Master-at-Arms School, and DOD Corrections curriculums.

Due to time limitations and logistics variability, the amount of M.A.C.H. based content acquired through the completion of any of the above schools represents an “entry level” comprehension of the full Controlled F.O.R.C.E. training capabilities.

The completion a “CF M.A.C.H. Sustainment Trainer” course sanctioned by the Controlled F.O.R.C.E. Corporate Office will provide the Servicemember with an “instructor level” comprehension of Levels 1 and 2 of the full Controlled F.O.R.C.E. training capabilities. Upon completion of the course, the Servicemember will have developed the ability to effectively transfer maximum amounts of his/her knowledge of the M.A.C.H. based CRSC content in short periods of time with high levels of retention to other members of his/her unit. Completion of the “CF M.A.C.H. Sustainment Trainer” course also authenticates the Servicemember as a Controlled F.O.R.C.E. Certified Sustainment Reinforcement Trainer, which provides the Servicemember with the full authorization and support of the Controlled F.O.R.C.E. Corporate Office to teach the system within his/her unit.

Further clarification on Controlled F.O.R.C.E. Sustainment Reinforcement Trainer Certification:

- **Authorizes Servicemember to teach Controlled F.O.R.C.E. proprietary content to the active duty personnel in his/her unit only.**
- Any issuance of certification other than those processed by the Controlled F.O.R.C.E. Corporate Office will not be recognized by Controlled F.O.R.C.E.
- No trainer or training course can include “Controlled F.O.R.C.E.” or “Mechanical Advantage Control Holds” on their own certificates without expressed written permission from the Controlled F.O.R.C.E. Corporate Office.
- The teaching of Controlled F.O.R.C.E. proprietary training to personnel outside of Servicemember’s department or unit is prohibited unless given expressed permission from the Controlled F.O.R.C.E. Corporate Office.
- The teaching of any Controlled F.O.R.C.E. proprietary training for monetary gain is strictly prohibited unless given expressed written permission from the Controlled F.O.R.C.E. Corporate Office.
- Any re-sellers of Controlled F.O.R.C.E. proprietary training will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law.
- Authorization to teach Controlled F.O.R.C.E. proprietary content expires two years after the completion of the most recent sustainment reinforcement trainer certification class attended, or when Servicemember is de-activated from military service, whichever comes first. At the end of the two year term, re-certification training is required in order to continue teaching Controlled F.O.R.C.E. proprietary training.
- Within the two year certification term, Servicemember may attend any open Controlled F.O.R.C.E. Course as a refresher at no charge. Free refresher training does not extend the two year certification term, but can be used to further develop sustainment reinforcement trainer skills.

Sustainment Reinforcement Trainer Certification authorizes Servicemember to teach and use Controlled F.O.R.C.E. training and copyrighted materials within the DOD unit he/she is assigned to at the time of

certification for a term of 2 years. If Servicemember becomes de-activated and gains employment with a civilian law enforcement or correctional agency within the two year certification term, Servicemember should contact Controlled F.O.R.C.E. promptly to transfer certification to his/her new agency. Upon request and approval, Controlled F.O.R.C.E. will transfer certification to new agency, which will authorize Servicemember to provide his/her knowledge of the system to personnel within that agency (transfer fees apply). Upon transfer of certification, Servicemember will remain eligible for re-certification rates on any future training.

Effective 1 October 2009

Mandatory upon completion of the “CF M.A.C.H. Sustainment Trainer” course, Servicemember must become a member of the Controlled F.O.R.C.E. Network to receive certifications. The Controlled F.O.R.C.E. Network is a Support System and Knowledge Base for Controlled F.O.R.C.E. Certified Trainers. The Network is the easiest and best way for certified trainers to stay up-to-date on important information.

TO RECEIVE YOUR CERTIFICATES UPON COMPLETION OF THE COURSE**

All certificates are issued electronically in PDF format via e-mail.

Paper certificates are available upon request for an additional fee.
