In a spontaneously occurring active shooter situation, survival and success depends on immediate reaction. F.O.R.C.E. ACTIVE SHOOTER course hones muscle memory, enabling the First Responder to immediately recall vital tactics under stress.

This rapid and intense course is packaged in compounding drill format to give you many reps so you can immediately recall survival skills when you need them the most. The unique Controlled F.O.R.C.E. compounding drill format generates drills from previous drills, allowing for maximum repetitions in short periods of time.

Course Covers:

SECTION 1: M.A.C.H. CLOSE RANGE SUBJECT CONTROL

Utilizes Mechanical Advantage Control Holds™ (M.A.C.H.) to enhance body movement for focusing on the environment while controlling an individual. Develops course terminology and team communication skills.

SECTION 2: SURVIVAL FORCE REACTIONARY DEFENSE

Builds skills to survive an initial surprise attack by any means necessary and dominate the attacker(s). Covers all force options and fosters a persevering attitude.

SECTION 3: COMBATIVE COUNTER MEASURES

Builds skills to maintain control of the environment by learning how to avoid tunnel vision and respond to new immediate threats as they occur in critical situations.

SECTION 4: HIGH-THREAT ENVIRONMENT CONTROL

Develops strong room entry, searching and clearing skills covering corner feed rooms, center feed rooms, stairways, hallways, and multiple entry/exit points. Addresses engaging multiple threats and cover and concealment.

SECTION 5: RAPID DEPLOYMENT SEARCH TEAM TRANSITIONS

Combines all training together into Lone Operator Tactics, 2 Man Tactics, 3 Man Tactics, 4 Man Tactics, 5 Man Tactics, 6 Man Tactics, and so on. Addresses improvised command post and integration of multiple agency responses.

COURSE OVERVIEW:

Controlled F.O.R.C.E. has spent the past several years developing a scenario-based curriculum that addresses spontaneously occurring, ongoing incidents that may involve an Active Shooter situation **where failure to act most likely will have catastrophic consequences resulting in multiple officer and/or civilian deaths.**

There are major key elements of tactical response that SWAT Operators spend a great deal of time honing in order to be able to re-gain control of a critical environment. Some of these key elements are necessary for the front-line officer to understand in order to survive and effectively control a critical environment as it spontaneously occurs. Controlled F.O.R.C.E. has developed a method of basic tactical response training formulated to the specific needs of the patrol officer.

Key elements of tactical response that the front-line officer must have an understanding of include:

- Individual and Team Dynamic Tactical Entry
- Individual and Team Tactical Ingress and Egress
- Improvised Team Tactics
- Room Clearing, Hallway Clearing, Stairway Clearing
- Threat Identification and Response
- Environment Control Measures

If recent trends in school shootings, church shootings, and even military base shootings teach us anything, it is that well armed, skilled gunmen with the motivation and determination to wreak havoc can cause massive loss of life in a matter of moments. What's more, we all know that routine situations such as domestic calls can turn extremely violent in an instant. The officers that respond to these situations must have a basic tactical response capability to effectively respond in a manner that eliminates all threats as quickly as possible.
